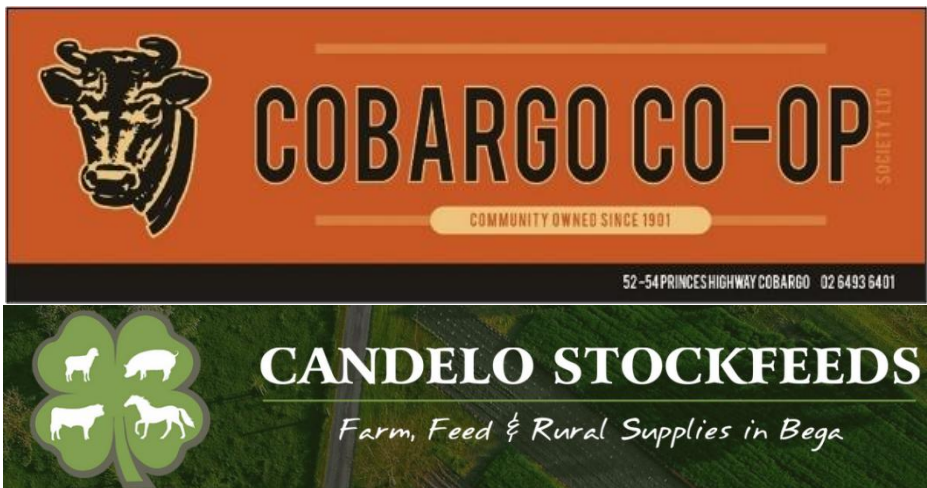

RULES & REGULATIONS

All competitors ride at their own risk. All competitors and people assisting on the arena must complete a Risk Waiver. Risk Waiver forms are available on Global and our website cobargoshow.org.au

Waiver Forms to be presented to the Entries Office to receive a **compulsory wristband**

- **RIDERS MUST BE CLEARED BY FIRST AID OFFICERS BEFORE BEING ALLOWED TO RIDE AGAIN AFTER A FALL. THIS APPLIES FOR ALL RIDERS whether on the arena or around the showground**
- **ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR APPROVED HELMETS WHENEVER ON HORSEBACK (EXERCISING & COMPETING), THIS INCLUDES RIDERS COMPETING IN RIDDEN ASH CLASSES, CAMPDRAFT & TEAM PENNING**
- **DRESS:** All competitors must be suitably attired which includes helmets & boots.
- **No person is allowed in the ring**, except for judges and stewards, while a competition is in progress. The judge's decision is final
- **No refunds for scratching** (unless due to ill health/accident/or at the discretion of the committee)
- **NOVICE** – Not placed first in an individual hack class or riding class at any Agricultural Show or equivalent show
- Competitors must choose between Hunter and Hack classes; cannot compete in both.
- **RINGS** will not be held up for competitors. If classes clash competitors must choose, except at the Chief Steward's and/or Judge's discretion
- **All horses & ponies** in Breed Classes must be registered with a Breed Society. **All owners & handlers** must be members. **Riding Pony** must be registered and must not exc 14.2hh
- All horses with a current official SHC or EA measuring certificate must compete in height shown on certificate
- **LED CLASSES** – Bits are not required for these classes, except for stallions
- **STALLIONS** are permitted to enter colour/breed classes and show jumping events
- **STALLIONS** are to wear a green disc & wear a bit when being led or ridden. They must be under control by a person 17yrs & over. ASH classes must be 18yrs & over
- **STALLIONS** must be always supervised and have 2 restraints when tied to a truck or float. **3 stallion yards will be available by booking with Shelli Allen – 0488 019 353**
- **The Show Committee** reserves the right to alter the program
- **All official protests** must be made in writing within one hour of the completion of judging of the said class and must be accompanied by \$50.00. The fee will be forfeited if the Committee considers the protest frivolous
- **This show is run** in accordance with the **ASC SHOW RULES**. Hacking & Horse Events run under **Show Horse Council Rules & Guidelines**. Any competitor found to have breached the ASC rules will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee. **EA** rules also apply
- **RESULTS** will be forwarded to the ASC for consideration and Showjumping to EA NSW
- **DRUG TESTING** may be carried out at this show
- **Only BATTERY** energized electrical fences allowed

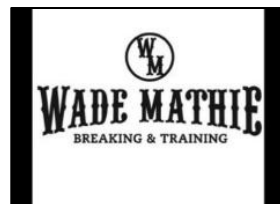

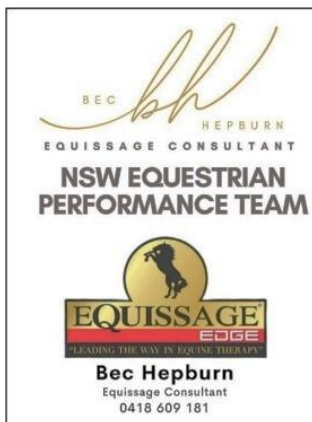

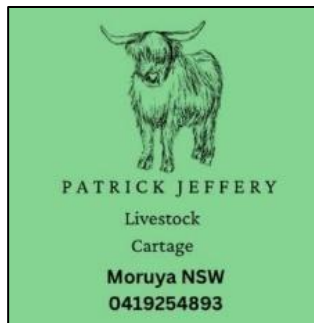
