RULES & REGULATIONS

CRUELTY TO ANIMALS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED

- **All competitors ride at their own risk.**
- **All competitors and persons assisting** on arena must complete an Indemnity form
- **No person is allowed in the ring**, with the exception of judges and stewards, while a competition is in progress. The judge's decision is final
- **DRESS:** All competitors must be suitably attired. **Approved Helmets** must be worn whenever on horseback (exercising or competing); except ASH classes
- **SHOWJUMPING competitors MUST wear EA approved TAGGED HELMETS**
- **No refunds for scratching** (unless due to ill health/accident/or at the discretion of the committee)
- **RINGS** will not be held up for competitors. If classes clash competitors must choose, except at the Chief Steward's and/or Judge's discretion
- **RIDING PONY CLASSES** – Must be registered and **MUST** not exceed 14.2hh.
- All horses with a current official SHC or EA measuring certificate must compete in height shown on certificate
- **NOVICE** – Not placed first in an individual hack class or riding class at any Agricultural Show or equivalent show
- Competitors must choose between Hunter and Hack classes; cannot compete in both.
- **NO STALLIONS** will be allowed to compete in open classes; to compete in allocated Stallion classes only, except ANSA and Stock Horse classes
- **STALLIONS** are permitted to enter colour/ breed classes and show jumping events
- **STALLIONS** are to be led or ridden by a person over 17 years with the exception of ASH which is 18 yrs & over
- **The Show Committee** reserves the right to alter the program
- **All official protests must be made in writing within one hour of the completion of judging of the said class and must be accompanied by \$50.00. The fee will be forfeited if the Committee considers the protest frivolous**
- **This show is run** in accordance with the **AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY COUNCIL SHOW RULES**. Hacking & Horse Events run under **SHOW HORSE COUNCIL RULES & GUIDELINES**. Any competitor found to have breached the ASC rules will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee.
- **RESULTS** will be forwarded to the ASC for consideration
- **Only BATTERY** energized electrical fences allowed on the showground
- **DRUG TESTING** may be carried out at this show
- **RIDERS** must be cleared by **First Aid** before being allowed to ride again after a **fall**

THE FAR SOUTH COAST SHOWJUMPER OF THE YEAR SERIES

Incorporating the Keith Gordon Senior Showjumper of the Year Award

And the Graham Johnson Junior Showjumper of the Year Award

The Far South Coast Showjumper of the year series was initiated in 2009 to honour the memory of two devoted contributors of the local showjumping circuit and the sport of show jumping. These awards will be presented to the HORSE and RIDER combination with the highest point score in the show jumping events of the SHOWS on the Far South Coast

RULES:

1. Shows eligible for the pointscore are: The Bega Show jumping Cup, Pambula Show, Candelo Show, Eurobodalla Show Moruya, Cobargo Show, FSC National Show (Bega) and Bemboka Show.
2. Combinations must compete at at least THREE (3) of the shows to be eligible for prizes.
3. Show jumping results, consisting of a single Horse and Rider entry in every ring, will be counted towards the point score.
4. For the purpose of this point score competition, the junior definition follows the EA definition: "All riders up to and including the calendar year in which they turn 18 (i.e. if the participant rider turns 18 in the year of competition they are an eligible junior. If they turned 18 the year before, they are senior".
5. Points will be awarded to the top FIVE placegetters as follows:
1st = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th=2 points, 5th= 1point. In the event of equal placing, the Horse and Rider combinations will take their awarded placing points (i.e. two in 1st places take 5 points each and 3rd place takes 3 points).
6. Points will be awarded to the Horse and Rider combination. An individual Horse can contest both junior and senior categories if the owner so wishes, as this will not affect the point scores in anyway. Contestants must be reminded that the HORSES WELFARE must be paramount at all times.
7. Only the TWO Best Performances of a Horse and Rider combination per day (if applicable), per show will count towards the points score.
8. If a junior competes in an OPEN event and placed, they will still take the points to the junior category point score.
9. Contestants must be reminded that the HORSES WELFARE is paramount. In line with EA directives, the number of starts a horse may have on the day is at the discretion of the judge and horse convenor.

Winners of the Far South Coast Showjumper of the Year Series for 2022 will receive a Prize and Horse Rug acknowledging their outstanding achievement at a Presentation Night organised by the Bega Showjumping Club at the conclusion of the show season.
