Entry Forms must be received by 10 am Friday and exhibits received by 1 pm Friday. A hanging sleeve must be attached to the back of each quilt by the exhibitor before exhibit is received for judging. Dimensions to be a finished depth of 10cm (4") by width of exhibit.

Judging commences at 3 pm Friday.
